



Veterinarian Release Form

The following veterinarian release form is required as a part of The Animal Welfare (Licensing of Activities Involving Animals) (England) Regulations 2018.

Overview

This agreement is in place to obtain the customers consent should Doggies Daycare staff need to act in the best interest of their dog in a medical emergency.

Circumstances

Should my dog become ill or injured whilst in the care of Doggies Daycare staff, they will be taken to my dog's registered veterinary practice for treatment.

I take full responsibility of ensuring the veterinarian practice details (stored electronically within the Collar App portal) are up to date and correct for my dog.

Should Doggies Daycare staff deem it a medical emergency, they will have the discretion to contact their locally registered veterinary practice for advice, and if necessary, act upon said advice.

Permission

I hereby authorise the attending veterinarian to treat my dog and I accept full responsibility for all fees and charges incurred in the treatment of my dog.

Doggies Daycare are authorised to transport my dog to and from the veterinary practice for treatment or request on-site treatment, if deemed necessary.

If Doggies Daycare staff deem it an emergency and no main contacts or emergency contact can be contacted, Doggies Daycare staff shall act on my behalf to authorise any treatment. Unless imperative for the welfare of the dog, euthanasia must not take place until consent is given.

I give permission to approve treatments up to the value of £1,000.

I will assume full responsibility upon my return for payment and/or reimbursement for veterinary services rendering up to the above stated amount.
